### Introduction.

- 1. What the Bible says about end times, last days, latter times, etc...could be covered in relatively a moderate amount of time.
- 2. What people have been led to believe the Bible says about the "end times" is another matter!! This would be almost a never ending discussion, on & on & on...

a. Some estimate that as much as ¼ to ½ of the Bible is made up of Bible prophesy (predicted prophesy?) Prophet = a spokes person for another.

b. It is claimed that almost everything happening in our world today is a fulfill-

ment of some Bible prophesy.

- c. Many claim to have discovered "the key" of understanding that unlocks the meaning of these so-called prophesies and how and when they are going to be fulfilled in our day and in time to come...(they have their time line of events) (signs of the times, rapture, Kingdom on earth, Antichrist, Armageddon, etc)
- 3. It is NOT my intent to study the books of Ezekiel, Daniel, Revelation, Matthew, BUT to deal with what is being taught today about the "end-times" will necessitate us studying different parts of these books, and others, in order to learn the truth as taught in the Bible about these matters.
- 4. Why would we want to study this subject in the first place?
  - a. It involves much of the religious discussion today in many of the denominational churches, TV preaching, advertisement, printed material... It's a whole system of theology & a method of Biblical interpretation.
  - b. If you have the opportunity to discuss the Bible with your neighbor, chances are great they may believe some or all of this teaching... 1Pet. 3:15
  - c. New Converts may come into the church with some of these beliefs.
  - d. Besides, we are commanded to "test the spirits" because many false prophets have gone out into the world... 11n.4:1-6

e. It will re-affirm our faith is the simplicity and power of truth in God's word.

- 5. I will be using the old fashion (like me) over-head projector. It will be visible on the wall to the left of the pulpit. Since the size of print is limited, you may want to sit closer to the front and in a location visible from your seat.
- 6. I would appreciate it VERY MUCH if when asking a question or making a comment to limit it to the subject matter under discussion if at all possible... There will be a logical order followed in this study....we will get there in time...

  - b. Kingdom established Dan 2:28, 44-45; 7:13-14

- 4. The nature of the Kingdom

  - b. No more carnal warfare <u>Isa 11:1-10; 2:4;</u> (Matt. 18:3-4; Rom. 15:12) <u>2Cor. 10:3-5;</u> (Eph. 6:10-18)
  - c. Expand the borders by teaching God's word Isa. 2:2-3; (Mt. 13:18-19)
- 5. The BIG mistake Israel made in the first century.
  - a. They viewed these prophesies & promises of the Messiah and His Kingdom in a literal way. They expected the Messiah to come, set up a kingdom on earth, reign on David's throne in the city of Jerusalem. There would be a restoration of Israel as in the glory days of David & Solomon. God would gather the scattered Jews and they would be a part of this great kingdom. Presumable, this Messiah (King) would over throw the yoke that Rome had over them and they would be a great & powerful nation again. Jn. 6:14-15

- When Jesus did not fit their mold and pre-conceived ideas of what they thought the messiah would be like when he came, they rejected Him. His teaching (turn the other cheek, love your enemies, repent) did not sound like the mighty King they were expecting. They rejected him as messiah in spite of the power of his speech (Mt. 7:28-29) and the miracles and mighty works which he did. (Mt. 11:20-23; Mt. 13:53-57; Acts 2:22)
- c. They plotted against Him in many ways, and eventually succeeded in having Him put to death by crucifixion. Acts 2:36 His rejection, suffering, betrayal, death & resurrection was part of God's

Plan (before the world began) and was predicted in the O.T. Scriptures.

Psa. 22; Isa. 53; Acts 2:23, 29-36 (Rev. 13:8; 1Pct. 1:18-21)

- 6. MANY preachers, evangelist and religious leaders in denomination churches (past and present) make the same mistakes as Israel's leaders did in the first century. They believe these promises and prophesies where supposed to be fulfilled in a literal way. That is, Jesus (messiah) came into the world to establish his kingdom on earth, sit and rule on David's throne in the city of Jerusalem for ONE THOUSAND YEARS, etc...etc....
  - a. Obviously that did not happen!!
  - b. Their solution is to teach that God postponed the fulfillment until some future date when Israel will be receptive and the time is right....
  - c. In the mean time, God instituted the "Church age" to fill in from the postponement till Jesus comes again. This time He will do all that was prophesied to happen. (could be failed again?)
  - d. Many believe this "church age" was totally unknown or promised in the Old Testament prophets and scriptures.
  - e. Some even believe that the rejection & sufferings of Christ was not a part of God's original plan!! But because of the rejection & suffering, God postponed...etc... and in came the "church age"
- 7. This whole system of doctrine is usually identified as PREMILLENVIALISM.
  - a. Pre = before, and millennial = 1,000. The doctrine that teaches that Christ will come before, then establish His kingdom and reign on earth for 1,000 years.
  - b. There are several variations within the teachings of a literal kingdom on earth, and matters concerning the coming of Christ and "end time" events.
  - c. We will identify and explain in more detail this system of false teaching Concerning the so-called "end times" theories next.

# Time & Order of ENDIEWE EVENTS

- 3. RAPTURE (taken from "caught up" 1Thes. 4:17)

The following is taken from a booklet entitled "The AntiChrist" pages 3 & 4. Here is an explanation of what some are said to believe about

"The advent of Christ and the AntiChrist"

- 1. Satan will appear as a man in the person of the AntiChrist because he seeks to reign as king over mankind and desires to focus the worship of God on himself.
  - 2. The AntiChrist will be a Jew, and will achieve his stated objectives by being accepted as the Christ, the messianic king of the Jews, taking his seat in the rebuilt temple in Jerusalem, pretending to be God Himself, and thereby becoming the "abomination of desolation" spoken of by the prophet Daniel and mentioned also by Jesus.<sup>5</sup>
  - 3. The AntiChrist is the 'little horn' of the fourth beast mentioned in Daniel 7. He will slay three of the other horns and reign as an eighth with the remaining seven.
  - 4. The AntiChrist will achieve his objectives in the middle of the final seven-year period of this age. At that time he will be proclaimed the messianic king of the Jews and will take his seat as God in the rebuilt temple in Jerusalem. He will reign for three and one-half years.
  - 5. The AntiChrist, during his reign, will deceive the majority of people living on the Earth at the time into believing he is God. However, he will persecute those who refuse to worship him because they are able to see through his delusion.
  - 6. Jesus Christ will return to Earth at the end of the three and one-half year reign of the AntiChrist, destroying Satan's kingdom. The resurrection of the just will occur at that time.

# 66 ANTICERSIST?

1John 2:18-19 "Children, it is the last hour, and just as you heard that antichrist is coming, even now many antichrists have arisen; from this we know that it is the last hour. They went out from us, but they were not really of us, for if they had been of us, they would have remained with us; in order that it might be shown that they all are not of us."

1John 2:21-23 "Who is a liar but the one who denies that Jesus is the Christ? This is the antichrist, the one who denies the Father and the son. Whoever denies the son does not have the Father; the one who confesses the son has the Father also."

1John 4:2-3 "By this you know the Spirit of God: every spirit that confesses that Jesus Christ has come in the flesh is from God; and every spirit that does not confess Jesus is not from God; and this is the spirit of the antichrist, of which you have heard that it is coming, and now it is already in the world."

2John 1:7 "For many deceivers have gone out into the world, those who do not acknowledge Jesus Christ as coming in the flesh. This is the deceiver and the antichrist."

From the Bible we can clearly see 3 things. First, the "antichrist" is defined as anyone who doesn't believe Jesus is the divine son of God. Second, "antichrists" appear to actively teach against Christ. Third, there were many "antichrists" in the world when John wrote the book. This directly contradicts the teaching of modern speculationists who say that one antichrist will arise at some still future time.

The Greek word from which we get our English word "antichrist" is translated is very simple to understand. It is a simple compound word and means "anti" + "Christ" = "antichrist". We us the same compound word everyday. We have people who are "anti-smoking: or "anti-gay" or "anti-hunting" or "anti-Semitic" or "anti-abortion". There really is no big mystery as to what the word means. "Anti-Christ" is anyone who opposes Christ.

The "antichrist" then, has no horns or red glowing eyes. Neither is the "antichrist" some demon possessed super-intelligent human clone. Rather, the "antichrist" is that sweet elderly lady living next door who openly teaches the neighborhood kids that Jesus just was a myth.

# BRIEF SUMMARY OF THE TIMES IN WHICH WE LIVE UNTIL THE END

Will Russia and some Arab nations invade Israel and the U.S.A. become involved? Yes.

Will I/4th of the world's population die? Yes.

VIII diseases such as AIDS increase? Yes.

Will a World leader called the Antichrist come forth? Yes.

Vill there be a one-world governing system? Yes.

Will there be an event called Armageddon? Yes.

Will Jesus Christ actually return? Yes.

Just as the rebirth of Israel happened as predicted (along with over 300 other predictions) so the rest of the prophecies shall come to pass.

THE FOOL HAS SAID IN HIS HEART, THERE IS NO GOD.

The Bible gives us over 360 prophecies that would come to pass; however, none of these meant anything until the predicted rebirth of Israel occurred. This event did happen in 1948. 





QUOTE from a booklet "A Study of Premillennialism" pub. by Guardian of Truth Foundation, article "Has the Land Promise been fulfilled" by Earl E. Robertson, pages 49, 50.

"Charles C. Ryrie, in his book, The Basis Of The Premillennial Faith, says the Abrahamic and Davidic covenants have not been fulfilled. He says, "The unconditional character of the Abrahamic covenant is the crucial issue in making the Abrahamic covenant a basis for premillennialism. If the covenant is unconditional, then the national aspect of it must yet be fulfilled, and premillennialism is the only system of interpretation which makes a place for a national future for Israel in which she possesses her land" (p. 52). Again, on page 60, he says, . "Since the covenant has never been fulfilled in history, if language means anything at all, it must have a future fulfillment." And among the things God promised Abraham which have not been fulfilled, he says, "specifically, the national promises." He says there have been three dispersions of the Jews, "The third and last dispersion began in 70 A.D. and continues to the present day. # THE PROPHICY OF DANIEL'S SEVENIY WEEKS

Let us, in this connection, briefly examine this fascinating prophecy. There is a three-fold thrust to the narrative.

First, it foretells the "Anointed" One's advent, and what would be accomplished thereby. The Messiah would: finish transgression, bring an end to sins, make reconciliation for iniquity, usher in everlasting righteousness, seal up vision and prophecy, be anointed as the most holy one, make firm a new covenant, and terminate sacrifices. These things are associated with Christ's redemptive work at Calvary—not his second coming. To suggest that Daniel's prophecy contains a "long parenthesis," the "church age" (between the 69th and 70th weeks), which was wholly unknown to the Old Testament prophets, is without any rational basis.

Second, the prophecy sets forth a chronological time-frame in which the messianic events would take place. From the time of Judah's commission to leave Babylonian captivity (in 457 B.C.), some 4861/2 years (set forth in three increments—with "days" signifying "years") would pass, thus terminating in the very year of Jesus' death (see the author's article on "Daniel's Seventy Weeks," elsewhere in our Archives).

Finally, the terrible price for the Jews' rejection of Jesus is graphically portrayed. "As a result or consequence of the death of the Messiah one making desolate (i.e. the Roman prince Titus) appears 'upon the wing of abominations' (i.e. the pinnacle of the temple). By this language the complete destruction of the temple is signified" (Young, 679).

It is not without significance that the Jews themselves recognized that the destruction of Jerusalem in A.D. 70 was the fulfillment of Daniel's prophecy. Josephus, the Jewish historian, stated that "Daniel also wrote concerning the Roman government, and that our country should be made desolate by them" (Antiquities, 10.11.7). This view of "Daniel's seventy weeks," commonly called the "traditional" view, "has been held with slight variation by most Biblical scholars until recent years" (Scott, 364).

# OURAPPROACH IN STUDYING THE BIBLE

- 1. The Bible is its own best interpreter. "Wherever we are able to correlate passages (in Matt, Rev., etc) with plain statements found elsewhere in the Bible, we have to understand them in this light." ALL scripture must harmonize with all others. Our interpretation must NOT contradict other passages of scripture. Similar words, phrases, language found in Matthew, Revelation, and other parts of the Bible must be compared for possible meaning and understanding.
- 2. We must proceed from the known to the unknown or more difficult parts. In regular Bible Study we are taught to master the "basics" then proceed to the more difficult. Should we not proceed on these basis in studying Revelation, Matthew, Daniel, etc. ?? There are similar words, phrases & contexts in other parts of the Bible that we do know what they mean...(Matt.; Dan. 2,7,9 etc...) These will help us understand what the "signs" in Matt 24:3 & Rev. 1:1 could be indicating, or identifying!! We should interpret the unknown, or the more difficult "signs" in harmony with the known signs and contexts.

### 3. SIGNS:

a. The first verse in <u>Revelation</u> says "...He sent and signified it..."

<u>Revelation</u> = to reveal, make known... NOT conceal or hide.

Sign language is used to reveal things to John --- 7 churches

"The revelation was "signified" by Christ through his angel to his servant John. The word translated "signified" means to show by signs. Thus we are introduced to the nature of the book. It is a revelation (unveiling) of God's message through signs (symbols). This must be kept in mind and follow if the truth of the book is to be known. Its message comes not through literal understanding of its words but through the interpretation of the symbols. It is a divine picture book."

# ADOCALYFIC SPEECH

# "The Book of Revelation" by Jim McGuiggan p. 14, 15

"Apocalyptic" speech is a phrase we moderns dug up. We use it to denote speech which is made up of symbols. In the New Testament there is only one book of "apocalyptic speech" although there are a number of examples of such speech in books written in "ordinary" speech. In the Old Testament apocalyptic speech pervades books such as Daniel, Ezekiel, Zechariah. In a number of other books (eg. Isaiah and Joel) there are many examples of apocalyptic speech.

The word itself denotes "an unveiling, or uncovering, a revealing." In light of the confusion which swirls around these books, it is hard for the average fellow to believe this. The truth is, we borrowed the word from the "Revelation of John" (ie. the book of Revelation) where the word was not used to describe the speech used. In Revelation 1:1 we are told God gave Jesus a "revelation" to John in symbolic speech. Paul "revealed" some things in ordinary speech but the last book in the New Testament - the last "revelation" was given in symbolic speech. Because this last book is called an "apocalypse" and it was given in symbolic speech, men then called books written in symbolic speech — apocalyptic.

Exactly what should be included in the term 'apocalyptic' is hard to say. Should a metaphor ('I am the door') be said to be 'apocalyptic' speech? Should we say any figurative expression is 'apocalyptic'?

You'll draw your own conclusion since I don't think the issue can be fully resolved. I'm of the opinion that it doesn't really matter in the end. This much we can say for sure: One can go through the Bible and without much difficulty gather together the sections of scripture which remind him of the book of Revelation. These sections sound like one another. They strike the same chord in our mind — they are in a class of their own. This may be because they not only sound alike, but they have the same general import.

Apocalyptic speech is lurid in its colors and very often violent in its tone. It strikes the imagination and grabs hold of the mind. Who, having read of it, can forget the seven-headed sea beast or the scarlet prostitute on its back? Whose mind does not boggle over the falling of the stars and the rolling up of the heavens? Apocalyptic speech is vivid and easily remembered. It appeals to our imagination. It is the language of conflict and victory. It is the language used when God smites the oppressor and vindicates his people. It is the language of crisis if not of persecution.

It is the extension of the Biblically familiar. See examples of it in Isaiah 13,34; Micah 1:2ff; Zephaniah 1:2ff; Jeremiah 4:11-26. In these we read of God's attack on the world of the ungodly. A repetition of past historical events.

The earth (of the ungodly) becoming once more "without form and void;" the heavens (of the ungodly) once more coming under attack as they did in the days of Pharaoh; another Sodom and Gomorrah judgement comes on Edom; and the earth's high places tremble again at God's presence as they did at Sinai.

This is certain, though an apocalyptic book may have material in it which is to be understood literally, we must reverse the usual rule of interpretation when approaching it. Here is the usual approach to a book: Understand it literally unless forced to do otherwise. In approaching an apocalyptic book the rule is: Understand it figuratively unless there is good reason to do otherwise.

Jesus had in mid only has generalon because he used the very same phrase earlier in the day to pronounce woes on the Pharisees, concluding with, "Verity, I say unto you, all these things shall come upon this generation (Mt. 23:36). Considering the repetition of the key phrase and the context, the only defensible conclusion is that the disciples would witness the fulfillment of His prophetic word, cul-Minating with the fall of Jerusalem and the dismanding of 

This remeration of Jews in Jesus' time is thotoughly described by Machew. It was faithless and perverse (17:17), unicpeniant, evil and sign-seeking (16:4), ill-tempered and capricious (11:16-19), wicked and very adulterous (16:4), evil-speaking, inhumane (23:4, 14), tradition-steeped (15:9), and sinful. It was destined for condemnation (12:42), for it had rejected the Christ (I.k. 17:25). It was worse than previous generations (12:45). In fact, Jesus promised to heap upon it the blood of prophets from Abel to Zechariah (23: 

The hypocritical Pharistes of that generation had shut up the kingdom of God against others (Mt. 23:13); and the lawyers had taken away the key of knowledge (I.k. 11:52). It was the generation that Peter admonished others to save themselves from (Act. 2:40), Decause the nation's disaster couse would be realized in 70 A.D.

That the generation of verse 34 is Christ's is also borne out by scholarship. The Greek word is gener, meaning age or progeny. . It does not denote a period of unlimited duration." Vine says that gener means "a whole multitude of men (a progeny) living at the same dine, especially those of 

All these things shall come upon this generation. The time reference is unmistakeable. Mt. 24-34 "Generation" in Thayer's Lexicon = "The whole multitude of men living at the same time."

Note: Many passages in N. T. speak of the Lord's "coming", but only these three speak of HIM "coming on the clouds". This is significant! (cf. Rev. 14:14-20)

- 2. Jesus is sitting on the right hand of God and coming in a figurative since to carry out what He said He would do! He said He would destroy Jerusalem (Mt. 24).
  - a. Just like Isa. 19:1-ff says, "the Lord rides on a swift cloud" in reference to His judgment against Egypt carried out by another nation. cf. Isa. 10:5-12
- 3. John tells the 7 charches:
  - 1:1, "things which must shortly take place"
  - 13, Whetine is near
  - 22:6, "must shordy take place"
  - 22.7, GBCHOID, I AM COMINE QUICKLY?
    - :10, "Do not seal the words of the prophesy of this book, for the time is at hand"
    - :20, "...Surely I am coming quickly. Amen. Even so, come Lord Jesus!" (soon or 400 yrs. Later?)

Did every eye see him? Did those who pierced Him see Him? Did the tribes (12) mourn because of Him? Did they see the great power of God executed by KING Jesus through the Roman armies as they destroyed Jerusalem/temple? (Mk. 13:29) Or, did they see these things happen WHEN the Roman Empire fell some 400 years later?

# REIGN WITH CHRIST FOR ONE THOUSAND YEARS

Rev. 20:1...10

The following is taken from the commentary on Revelation, "The Avenging of the Apostle and the Prophets" by Arthur M. Ogden, pages 359, 360.

"The premillennial view. The majority of those who speculate upon these verses hold to the doctrine of premillennialism. They teach that the first resurrection is the resurrection of the dead saints at the adverti of Christ. They believe the first resurrection preceeds a 1,000 year reign of Christ on earth from Jerusalem. Needless to say, no doctrine of man was ever more void of proof. This text says nothing about a bodily resurrection of anyone. It does not mention the second coming of Christ, the reign of saints on the earth or the reign of Christ upon earth. The fact is, the scriptures no where indicate that Christ will ever set foot upon this earth again. The doctrines of premillennialism are highly materialistic and bear a close resemblance to the doctrines of the Jews who rejected Christ as the Messiah, crucified Him, and then persecuted His followers. It is not the purpose of this study to deal with the various theories of premillennialism, or the arguments which show them to be fallacious. Other works adequately expose these errors. Our purpose is to elicit the truth of the passage, and the truth will not support the doctrines of premilennialism."

# REIGN WITH CHRIST FOR ONE THOUSAND YEARS Rev. 20:1-10

The following is taken from "Revelation. An Introduction and Commentary" by Homer Hailey, pages 389, 390.

# THE THOUSAND YEARS vv. 1...10

This section is composed of seven parts, each beginning with, "And I saw" (19:11, 17, 19; 20:1, 4, 11; 21:1). In the battle of Har-Magedon the beast and the false prophet were cast into the lake of fire that burns with brimstone (19:19–21). With the defeat of these two and the destruction of the harlot, Satan has lost his allies. What becomes of him and the victory of the saints is the chief subject of 20:1–10, rather than the "thousand years," which usually receives the emphasis.

From the early centuries of Christianity this passage has been used as the basis for various theories of a thousand year reign of Christ on earth. For a brief but excellent summary of the history of millenarianism and four specific theories based on the passage, see Albertus Pieters (pp. 278-311). The general theory, with variations among different schools, is briefly this: Christ will come in the first phase of his return to earth (called 'the rapture'), and at this time the righteous dead will be raised, the living saints will be changed and both will be caught up in the air to meet the Lord. Then will come the marriage feast of the Lamb, during which there will be great tribulation on earth. After the wedding He and the bride, the church, will then complete the return to earth (called 'the revelation,") where Christ will set up His kingdom, sit on David's throne and reign from Jerusalem for a literal thousand years—the millennium. According to some, the Jews will be converted and return to Palestine, Old Testament worship will be restored (with modifications) and there will be on earth an idealistic life which will continue for the definite period of one thousand years. At the end of this millenium Satan will be loosed for a short time and make a last furious effort, to destroy the Lord's people and work. This will be followed by the resurrection of the wicked dead (for the righteous dead will have been raised at the beginning of the thousand years). The judgment will occur and the eternal destinies of heaven or hell will be meted.

The theory must read into the passage (vv. 1–10) all that it claims to draw from it, for the following are not mentioned in the text: (1) the second coming of Christ, (2) a bodily resurrection, (3) a reign of Christ on earth, (4) the literal throne of David, (5) Jerusalem of Palestine, (6) conversion of the Jews, or (7) the church on earth. A theory that rests on a passage of Scripture in which not one of its peculiar tenets of doctrine is found cannot be true!

This Day of Wrath on the Jewish Nation would "come to pass in the last days..." (the very LAST DAYS OF THE JEWISH NATION) and Peter (quoting the Prophet Joel) said would show wonders in heaven above and signs in earth beneath, blood and fire and vapor and smoke, and the sun would be turned into darkness and the moon into blood, BEFORE THE COMING OF THE GREAT AWESOME DAY of the Lord." The crucified and resurrected Lord was coming to destroy the apostates. This was to be the Great Day of the outpoured wrath of the Lamb - whom they had slain!

"Who can stand before God's indignation?" No one! "Who can endure the fierceness of His anger?" No one! Nahum 1:6.

The Biblical expression "LAST DAYS" properly refers to the period from the Advent of Christ until the destruction of the Jewish system and nation in AD 70. The "last days" of Israel during the transition period (AD 30 to 70) from the OLD Covenant to the NEW Covenant - those days are the "last days."
